By Mr. Cahir of Bourne, petition of Jeremiah F. Cahir (by vote of the town) that the town of Falmouth be authorized to grant an additional license for the sale of alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises to Three Way Enterprises, Inc. Government Regulations. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF FALMOUTH TO GRANT AN ADDITIONAL LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT TO BE DRUNK ON THE PREMISES TO THREE WAY ENTERPRISES, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section seventeen of chapter
2 one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the licensing
3 authority of the town of Falmouth is hereby authorized to issue to
4 Three Way Enterprises, Inc. a license under the provisions of
5 section fifteen of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight. Said
6 license shall be subject to the provisions of said chapter one
7 hundred and thirty-eight except section seventeen.
