AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PLYMOUTH-CARVER REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Amounts required for the payment of principal
2 and interest on any bonds or notes issued by the Plymouth-Carver
3 Regional School District for the construction and equipping of a
4 new comprehensive regional high school pursuant to the vote
5 adopted by the regional high school committee of said District on
6 October 28, 1980 and approved by the town of Plymouth on
7 November 17, 1980 and by the town of Carver on December 5,
8 1980, shall be excluded from any limitations contained in Section
9 20A and Section 21C of Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as
10 inserted by Chapter 580 of the Acts of 1980, and any acts in
11 amendment thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This question of acceptance of this act shall be
2 presented to the voters of the towns of Plymouth and Carver at
3 town elections called for the purpose and held in said towns on a
4 date selected by the Plymouth-Carver regional district school com-
5 mittee, after consultation with the boards of selectmen of said
6 towns. The question to be placed on the ballot for said elections
7 shall be substantially as follows:

8 Shall the amounts required for the payments of principal and
9 interest on bonds or notes issued by the Plymouth-Carver Region-
10 al School District for the construction and equipping of a new
11 comprehensive regional high school be excluded from any limita-
12 tions on the amounts by which assessments by said District may be
13 increased in any year and from any limitations on the amount of
14 taxes that may be assessed for such purpose by the Towns of
15 Plymouth and Carver in any year?

16 Each town election held under this section shall be called and
17 conducted in accordance with the provisions of law applicable
18 thereto, except as may otherwise be provided herein, and all ex-
19 penses of said town elections shall be paid by the Plymouth-Carver
20 Regional School District.

1 SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act shall take effect upon its
2 passage and section 1 shall take effect upon its acceptance by the
3 town of Plymouth and by the town of Carver, acceptance by each
4 town to be by a majority of the voters present and voting on the
5 question at the town elections described in section 2.
