AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DETERMINATION OF WAGE RATES UNDER CONTRACTS FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PUPILS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7A of Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 286 of the Acts of 1976 is hereby amended by
3 striking out the third sentence of the second paragraph thereof and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —

5 The determined rate per hour of said wages to be paid to each
6 person employed by the bidder in cities and towns outside of the
7 Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority shall not be less than
8 those established by collective bargaining agreements or under-
9 standings between organized labor and employers in such city or
10 town for operators of motor buses; provided, however that collec-
11 tive agreements or understandings pertaining to services to be
12 provided under contract with any regional transit authority should
13 not be included in said determination; and provided further that in
14 cities or towns where such rate or rates have been so established,
15 the wages determined shall not be less than the wages for that type
16 of employment by such bidders.
