AN ACT ALLOWING THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER TO DISCHARGE CERTAIN WASTEWATER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of sections fourteen, fifteen,
- 2 sixteen and eighteen of chapter one hundred and thirty-two A of
- 3 the General Laws, the city of Gloucester may build and discharge
- 4 from a primary wastewater treatment facility with an extended
- 5 outfall as described in, and submitted to the administrator of the
- 6 environmental protection agency of the federal government as the
- 7 application of said city for a waiver of the secondary wastewater
- 8 treatment requirement as provided by 33 USC 1343.
