*Ordered*, That the Committee on Natural Resources and Agriculture be authorized to sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of current house document numbered 6566, appendix K, relative to establishing Title V of the State Environmental Code as a uniform standards code.

Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may require by summons the attendance and testimony of witnesses, may travel within and without the commonwealth and may expend for expert, legal, clerical and other services and for expenses and such sums as may be appropriated therefore.

Said committee shall report to the general court from time to time the result of its investigation and study its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of December nineteen hundred and eighty-one.
