AN ACT RECLASSIFYING JOHN O. WOLFGRAM, HARABORMASTER OF THE TOWN OF MARBLEHEAD, IN THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
