By Mrs. Hicks of Wayland, petition of Lucile P. Hicks (by vote of the town) that the positions of plumbing inspector and sealer of weights and measures in the town of Wayland be exempt from provisions of the civil service law and rules. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE TOWN OF WAYLAND FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW AND RULES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The positions of plumbing inspector and sealer of
2 weights and measures in the town of Wayland shall be exempt from
3 the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section one shall not impair the
2 civil service status of any plumbing inspector or sealer of weights
3 and measures in the town of Wayland holding civil service status
4 on the effective date of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
