By Mr. Navin of Marlborough, petition of Joseph M. Navin and Chester G. Atkins (with the approval of the mayor and city council) that the position of supervisor of custodians and maintenance in the school department of the city of Marlborough be exempt from provisions of the civil service law and rules. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-One.

AN ACT EXEMPTING THE POSITION OF SUPERVISOR OF CUSTODIANS AND MAINTENANCE IN THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF MARLBOROUGH FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW AND RULES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The position of supervisor of custodians and  
2 maintenance in the school department of the city of Marlborough  
3 shall not be subject to the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the  
4 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section one shall not impair the  
2 civil service status of any person employed in a permanent status in  
3 the position of supervisor of custodians and maintenance in the  
4 school department of the city of Marlborough, on the effective date  
5 of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
