AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF PROCEEDS OF SALE OF SCHOOL PROPERTIES BY THE CITY OF MEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of General Laws Chapter 44
- 2 Section 63 or the provisions of any other law to the contrary, the
- 3 City of Medford is hereby authorized to expend for any govern-
- 4 mental purposes, the proceeds from the sale of school properties,
- 5 provided that there is no indebtedness outstanding on such proper-
- 6 ties at the time of sale by the City.
