## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT EXEMPTING ALL POSITIONS IN THE CITY KNOWN AS THE TOWN OF AGAWAM FROM THE PROVISIONS OF CIVIL SERVICE LAWS AND RULES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. All positions in all departments in the city known  
2 as the town of Agawam shall not be subject to the provisions of  
3 chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance to the  
2 voters of the city known as the town of Agawam at its next regular  
3 election in the form of the following question which shall be placed  
4 on the official ballot to be used in said election:— Shall an act  
5 passed by the General Court in the year nineteen hundred and  
6 eighty-one entitled 'An act exempting all positions in the city  
7 known as the town of Agawam from the provisions of civil service  
8 law and rules be accepted?' If a majority of the votes in answer to  
9 said question is in the affirmative, this act shall thereupon take full  
10 effect, but not otherwise.
