AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF A SECTION 101 RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE TO BERNARD LONERGAN OF THE CITY OF SOMERVILLE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section one hundred and one
- 2 of Chapter thirty-two of the General Laws to the contrary, Bernard
- 3 Lonergan of the city of Somerville shall be entitled to and shall
- 4 receive an allowance authorized by said section one hundred and
- 5 one and shall be treated, for the purposes of this act, as if he is a
- 6 widow of a deceased former employee.
