

ACTS, 1984. - Chap. 295.

"Program", any program of community supervision and services certified or approved by the commissioner of probation under the provision of section eight, including, but not limited to, medical, educational, vocational, social and psychological services, corrective and preventive guidance, training, performance of community service work, counseling, provision for residence in a halfway house or other suitable place, and other rehabilitative services designed to protect the public and benefit the individual.

Chap. 295. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ZONING BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BARNSTABLE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1.. Chapter 215 of the acts of 1984 is hereby amended by striking out section 5 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 5. There is hereby established a zoning board of appeals in the town of Barnstable consisting of five members and as many associate members as required to be appointed by the board of selectmen. The members shall be appointed for three year terms so arranged that as nearly as possible one-third of the terms shall expire each year. The board of selectmen may appoint not more than six associate members for similar terms in the same manner. The board shall elect a chairman and clerk from its own membership each year. Members may only be removed for cause by the board of selectmen after a hearing.

The board shall hear and decide on appeals from decisions of administrative officials, applications for special permits and for variances, all as provided for in chapter forty A of the General Laws and the zoning by-laws of the town. The board shall act as a board of appeals on matters relating to subdivision control under the applicable sections of chapter forty-one of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of July thirteenth, nineteen hundred and eighty-four.
