AN ACT

To enable the Newton-Cemetery Corporation to purchase Certain Land for the Protection of its Cemetery.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECTION 1. The Newton-Cemetery Corporation
2 is hereby authorized to purchase a parcel of land
3 upon Walnut Street, in Newton, opposite the ceme-
4 tery of said corporation, and bounded westerly by
5 Walnut Street, northerly by Homer Street, easterly
6 by land now or formerly of J. D. Towle, and south-
7 erly by land now or formerly of Josiah Rutter, and
8 to hold and use said land for the purpose of supply-
9 ing earth and gravel for grading its cemetery, and
10 to protect said cemetery from nuisance or injury ;
11 and said corporation shall not be required to devote
12 said land to the purposes mentioned in chapter

13 twenty-eight of the General Statutes, or the acts in
14 addition thereto.

1 SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby authorized
2 to mortgage said land, or any part of the same, to
3 secure the whole or any part of the purchase-money
4 thereof, and, in case it shall hereafter desire to do
5 so, to sell and convey said land, or any part of the
6 same, to any purchaser.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
