AN ACT

In addition to "An Act to amend Chapter Forty-four of the General Statutes in relation to the Repair of Highways, and Remedies for Injuries sustained thereon."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter two hundred
2 and thirty-four of the acts of the year eighteen hun-
3 dred and seventy-seven is hereby amended by strik-
4 ing out the words "or to any police-officer," in the
5 fourth and fifth lines of said section, and by adding
6 after the word "behalf," in the eighth line, the
7 words "and shall in every case be in writing signed
8 by the person injured, or by some person thereto by
9 him duly authorized."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall not affect any action now
2 pending, or cause of action now existing.
