Bill accompanying the petition of John C. Ross and others, pilot commissioners of Boston, for legislation to regulate non-compulsory pilot rates to landings in Boston harbor. Mercantile Affairs. January 7.

AN ACT

To regulate Non-Compulsory Pilot Rates to Landings in
Boston Harbor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The rates to be paid for pilotage on vessels
2 being piloted inside of the outer limits of Boston harbor
3 to and from all landings within said harbor shall be fixed
4 by the pilot commissioners, but this provision shall not be
5 applicable to compulsory sea pilotage rates as now estab-
6 lished by law.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
