## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Salaries and Expenses of the Gas and Electric Light Commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are  
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the gas and electric  
3 light commissioners' fund, for the salaries and ex-  
4 penses of the gas and electric light commissioners,  
5 for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of  
6 November, nineteen hundred and ten, to wit:—

7 For the salaries of the commissioners, eleven  
8 thousand dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 121, sect. 1; Acts  
9 1904, ch. 435; 1907, ch. 316; 1908, ch. 655.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$11,000.)

10 For clerical assistance, a sum not exceeding five  
11 thousand dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 121, sects. 2 and  
12 3; Acts 1904, ch. 435; 1908, ch. 536.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$5,800.)

13 For statistics, books, stationery and other neces-  
14 sary expenses, a sum not exceeding thirty-three

15 hundred dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 121, sect. 3; Acts  
16 1904, ch. 435; 1908, ch. 536.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$3,000.)

17 For rent of an office, a sum not exceeding forty-  
18 two hundred dollars. (Acts 1908, ch. 655.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$4,200.)

19 For the inspection of electric meters, a sum not  
20 exceeding one thousand dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch.  
21 121, sects. 36 and 37.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$1,000.)

22 For the salary of the present gas inspector,  
23 twenty-eight hundred dollars. (Acts 1902, ch. 228;  
24 1908, ch. 536.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$2,800.)

25 For the salary of the present first assistant in-  
26 spector, eighteen hundred dollars. (Acts 1902, ch.  
27 229; 1908, ch. 536.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$1,800.)

28 For the salary of the present second assistant  
29 inspector, sixteen hundred dollars. (Acts 1902, ch.  
30 228; 1908, ch. 536.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$1,600.)

31 For compensation of deputies, travelling ex-  
32 penses, apparatus, office rent and other incidental  
33 expenses, a sum not exceeding eight thousand dol-  
34 lars. (Acts 1902, ch. 228.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$8,000.)

35 For printing and binding the annual report, a  
36 sum not exceeding eighteen hundred dollars. (Rev.  
37 Laws, ch. 9, sect. 7; Acts 1902, ch. 438.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$1,800.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
