## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Publication of a Record of Massachusetts Soldiers and Sailors who served in the War of the Rebellion.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of twelve thousand dollars  
2 is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treas-  
3 ury of the commonwealth, from the ordinary  
4 revenue, for expenses in connection with the pub-  
5 lication of a record of Massachusetts troops and  
6 officers, sailors and marines, in the war of the  
7 rebellion, for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth  
8 day of November, nineteen hundred and ten. (Acts  
9 1899, ch. 475; 1908, ch. 491.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$12,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
