Bill accompanying the petition of A. Preston Chase for legislation relative to subsistence furnished to members of the militia and to the cost thereof. Military Affairs. January 21.

AN ACT

Relative to Subsistence furnished to the Militia.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. When subsistence furnished in kind
2 for enlisted men and bandsmen of the militia shall
3 cost less than an average of forty-five cents for
4 each enlisted man and enlisted member of a band,
5 the difference shall be paid into the treasury of the
6 company concerned.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
