AN ACT

Relative to Charges for Gas Meters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twelve of chapter fifty-eight of
2 the Revised Laws is hereby amended by striking out the
3 last sentence and inserting in place thereof the follow-
4 ing:— No charge shall be made for the use of a meter
5 or for furnishing the same.

1 SECTION 2. Violation of the provisions of this act
2 shall be punished by fine or imprisonment at the dis-
3 cretion of the court.
