

HOUSE No. 885

Bill accompanying the petition of John D. Brooks for legislation to reimburse the town of Natick for money expended for the maintenance of the Natick Industrial School. Education. January 26.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

AN ACT

To provide for Repayment to the Town of Natick of Money expended by the Town for the Support of the Natick Industrial School.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There shall be allowed and paid out of
2 the treasury of the commonwealth to the town of Natick
3 the sum of two hundred and sixty-two dollars and sixty-
4 one cents, being one half of the cost of maintaining the
5 Natick industrial school, and the said sum being payable
6 to the said town in accordance with the provisions of
7 chapter five hundred and five of the acts of the year
8 nineteen hundred and six, as amended by chapter five
9 hundred and seventy-two of the acts of the year nine-
10 ten hundred and eight.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
