

HOUSE No. 939

Bill accompanying the petition of Maurice F. Kennedy for legislation to require the licensing board for the city of Boston to grant licenses in the various districts of the city according to the population. The Liquor Law. January 26.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

AN ACT

To authorize the Licensing Board for the City of Boston to issue Licenses according to Population in Each Section of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The licensing board may grant licenses of
2 any class in all sections of Boston according to the popu-
3 lation. Boston proper to have not more than one to each
4 five hundred inhabitants, and the suburbs to have not
5 more in any event than one license to each one thousand
6 inhabitants. The licensing board shall distribute the
7 licenses at their disposal in this manner.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
