Bill accompanying the petition of Thomas J. Murphy for legislation to provide for compensating city and town employees when engaged in the service of the militia. Military Affairs. January 26.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

AN ACT

To provide Compensation for Military Duty performed by
Employees of Cities and Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. On the receipt of a proper notice from
2 the commanding officer of any company of the state mili-
3 tia, by the head of a department or officer having super-
4 vision over or the employing of persons in the cities and
5 towns in the commonwealth, that a member of his depart-
6 ment is ordered for military duty, that said head of de-
7 partment or officer, shall carry name of such employee
8 upon the pay rolls of such department and receive the
9 same recompense while in the discharge of said military
10 duty as he would receive in the discharge of his duties
11 while an employee of the city or town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
