AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Maintenance of the Westborough State Hospital.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated for the maintenance of the West-
3 borough state hospital for the fiscal year ending
4 on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred
5 and ten, to wit:—
6 From the receipts of said hospital now in the
7 treasury of the commonwealth, seventy thousand
8 six hundred seventy-three dollars and eighty-one
9 cents, and from the treasury of the commonwealth,
10 from the ordinary revenue, a sum not exceeding one
11 hundred ninety-nine thousand three hundred
12 twenty-six dollars and nineteen cents. (Acts 1905,
13 ch. 175; 1909, ch. 504.)
