Bill accompanying the petition of Clarence W. Rowley for legislation to determine the legal residence of voters and tax payers on the first day of May. Taxation. January 26.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

AN ACT

To determine the Legal Residence of Voters and Tax Payers
on the First Day of May.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The legal residence of any person in this
2 commonwealth on the first day of May in each year shall
3 be the town or city in which such person has actually
4 resided during the greater portion of the six months next
5 preceding said first day of May.

1 SECTION 2. Every person owning personal property
2 subject to taxation in this commonwealth, and every per-
3 son who is registered as a voter, who during the six months
4 next preceding the first day of May has resided in two or
5 more places in this commonwealth shall file with the
6 assessors of taxes between the first and tenth days of May
7 a statement under oath setting forth each place in which
8 he has resided, and the period of time during which he has
9 resided in each.
