AN ACT

Relative to the Number of Doorkeepers, Assistant Doorkeepers, Messengers and Pages of the Senate and House.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section fifteen of chapter ten of the
2 Revised Laws is hereby amended by striking out,
3 in the third line, the word " thirty-eight ", and
4 inserting in place thereof the word: — forty, — so
5 as to read as follows:— *Section 15.* The number
6 of doorkeepers, assistant doorkeepers, messengers
7 and pages of the senate and house shall not exceed
8 forty in all.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
