AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Maintenance of the
Wrentham State School.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated for the maintenance of the Wren-
3 tham state school for the fiscal year ending on the
4 thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and
5 ten, to wit:—

6 From the receipts of said school now in the
7 treasury of the commonwealth, the sum of four
8 hundred twenty-five dollars and sixty-five cents,
9 and from the treasury of the commonwealth from
10 the ordinary revenue, a sum not exceeding forty-
11 eight thousand five hundred seventy-four dollars
12 and thirty-five cents. (Acts 1906, ch. 508; 1907,
13 ch. 421; 1909, ch. 504.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
