## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Maintenance of the  
Massachusetts Hospital School.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are  
2 appropriated to be paid for the maintenance of  
3 the Massachusetts hospital school for the fiscal  
4 year ending on the thirtieth day of November,  
5 nineteen hundred and ten, to wit:—

6 From the receipts of said school now in the  
7 treasury of the commonwealth, the sum of eleven  
8 thousand seventy-six dollars and eight cents; and  
9 from the treasury of the commonwealth from the  
10 ordinary revenue, a sum not exceeding forty-three  
11 thousand nine hundred twenty-three dollars and  
12 ninety-two cents. (Acts 1904, ch. 446; 1907, ch.  
13 226; 1909, ch. 504.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$37,138.53.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
