AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Expenses of the Massachusetts Nautical Training School.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for ex-
4 penses of the Massachusetts nautical training
5 school for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth
6 day of November, nineteen hundred and ten, to
7 wit:—

8 For the current expenses of the school, a sum not
9 exceeding sixty thousand dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch.
10 45; Acts 1903, ch. 171.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$58,000.)

11 For expenses of the commissioners, the salary
12 of the secretary, clerical services, printing, station-
13 ery, contingent office expenses and printing and
14 binding the annual report, a sum not exceeding five
15 thousand dollars. (Rev. Laws, ch. 45; Acts 1903,
16 ch. 171.)

(Appropriation 1909, \$5,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
