AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Maintenance of the
Lakeville State Sanatorium.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding seventy-five
2 thousand nine hundred and ninety dollars is hereby
3 appropriated to be paid out of the treasury of the
4 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
5 maintenance of the Lakeville state sanatorium for
6 the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of No-
7 vember, nineteen hundred and ten: *provided, how-*
8 *ever,* that no portion of the sum herein appropriated
9 shall be available until said sanatorium shall be
10 fully equipped and declared open and ready for
11 occupancy, as provided for by section seven of
12 chapter four hundred and seventy-four of the acts
13 of the year nineteen hundred and seven.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
