### AN ACT

Relative to the Payment of Commissions to Life Insurance Agents on Premiums on Policies on their Own Lives.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section sixty-nine of chapter five hundred  
2 and seventy-six of the acts of the year nineteen hundred  
3 and seven is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof  
4 the following paragraph:— But nothing in this section  
5 shall prevent the payment by any life insurance company  
6 to a duly authorized agent or broker who holds himself  
7 out and carries on business in good faith as such of com-  
8 missions at its customary rates on premiums on policies  
9 effected through him by the company on his own life.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
