AN ACT

Relative to Sales and Conveyances of Land to the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 No officer or employee of the commonwealth, and no
- 2 member of a state board or commission or board of trustees
- 3 of a state institution, and no officer or employee of any
- 4 such board, commission or board of trustees, shall act as
- 5 agent or attorney of any person or corporation in a sale
- 6 or conveyance of land to the commonwealth.
