

HOUSE No. 1382

Bill accompanying the petition of George H. Stevens for legislation to authorize the city of Lowell to supply water in the town of Dracut. Water Supply. March 10.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Lowell to supply a Part of the Town of Dracut with Water.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Lowell may distribute
2 water to the inhabitants of that part of Mammoth
3 road, so called, in the town of Dracut, which is
4 south of Ledge hill, and to the inhabitants of
5 streets leading from the said part of the said road,
6 and may regulate the use of such water and fix
7 and collect rates for the same, and may establish
8 and maintain fountains and hydrants in the said
9 district, and may relocate or discontinue the same.
10 For the purposes aforesaid the city of Lowell may,
11 with the permission of the selectmen of the town

12 of Dracut, construct and lay conduits, pipes and
13 other works under or over any lands, railroads,
14 railways, public or private ways, and along any
15 such ways in the said district as not unnecessarily
16 to obstruct the same, and may enter upon and dig
17 up any such lands and ways: *provided*, that the said
18 city shall restore to the satisfaction of the select-
19 men of the said town the public ways dug up or
20 otherwise disturbed in said town by the city, and
21 shall pay all damages sustained by any person in
22 consequence of any act or neglect upon the part
23 of the said city, its agents or employees in digging
24 up or otherwise disturbing any lands or public or
25 private ways within the said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
