SECTION 5. This act shall take effect on April first, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.

Chap. 331. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF THE PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF CERTAIN REAL ESTATE BY THE CITY OF MEDFORD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section sixty-three of chapter forty-four of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the city of Medford is hereby authorized to expend for any governmental purposes, the proceeds from the sale of real estate known as the Hancock School located on Hancock street in said city; provided, however, that there is no indebtedness outstanding relative to such real estate at the time of such sale.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 332. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE OPERATION OF LIFE INSURANCE DEPARTMENTS OF SAVINGS BANKS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 8 of chapter 178 of the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:- Expenses pertaining to the conduct of both the savings department and the insurance department, such as office rent and the salaries of general officers, shall be apportioned by the trustees equitably between the two departments in a manner approved by the state actuary.

Chap. 333. AN ACT INCREASING THE TERM OF VALIDITY OF LICENSES FOR FIREARMS DEALERS FROM ONE YEAR TO THREE YEARS.
