AN ACT

Relative to the Purchase of Land by the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-eight of chapter six of the Re-
2 vised Laws is hereby amended by adding at the
3 end thereof the words:— Whenever the attorney-
4 general shall certify to the auditor of the common-
5 wealth that the payment of a sum of money is
6 required to complete a purchase of land by the
7 commonwealth, the auditor shall certify such
8 amount and the governor may draw his warrant
9 therefor, in accordance with the provisions of this
10 section.
