## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Preparation and Publication of a Supplement to the Revised Laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are  
2 appropriated to be paid out of the treasury of the  
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the  
4 preparation and publication of a supplement to  
5 the Revised Laws, as provided for by chapter two  
6 hundred and forty of the acts of the year nineteen  
7 hundred and eight, to wit:—

8 For expenses in connection with the preparation  
9 and publication of a supplement to the Revised  
10 Laws, the sum of seventeen hundred fourteen dol-  
11 lars and ninety-five cents, the same to be in addi-  
12 tion to the five thousand dollars appropriated by  
13 chapter four hundred nineteen of the acts of the  
14 year nineteen hundred and eight.

15 For printing and binding the supplement to the  
16 Revised Laws, the sum of twelve thousand one  
17 hundred seventy-seven dollars and thirty-six cents.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
