## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

### AN ACT

To increase the Amount of Money that may be raised by Taxation in the Fire District of the Town of Huntington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section four of chapter three hundred and forty-  
2 three of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
3 ninety-eight is hereby amended by striking out in  
4 the last line but one of said section the word  
5 "tenth", and inserting in place thereof the word:  
6 —fifth,—so as to read as follows:—*Section 4.*  
7 Said district may, at meetings called for that pur-  
8 pose, raise money for the purpose of carrying out  
9 the provisions of this act; and said prudential com-  
10 mittee shall expend the same for the purposes

11 designated by vote of the district. Every member  
12 of said committee shall be accountable to said dis-  
13 trict for any money received by him, and said  
14 district may maintain a suit therefor in the name  
15 of the inhabitants of said district. Said committee  
16 shall not expend any money which has not been  
17 duly appropriated by the district, and shall have  
18 no authority to bind the district to the payment  
19 of money in excess of its appropriation or for any  
20 purpose not specified by the vote of the district  
21 appropriating the same. But said district shall not  
22 during any year raise by taxation any amount of  
23 money exceeding one fifth of one per cent. of the  
24 taxable property in said district.
