RESOLVE

In Favor of William H. Burpee, Executor of the Will of
Porter Piper.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth to William H. Burpee,
3 executor of the will of Porter Piper, late of Leominster,
4 Massachusetts, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars,
5 said amount being the sum paid the commonwealth on
6 September twenty-sixth, nineteen hundred and seven, by
7 mistake as a collateral inheritance tax on a legacy which
8 by law was exempt from said tax.
