In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

AN ACT

Relative to Public Morality.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Whoever in the presence of minors
2 eighteen years old or under exhibits, sets up, sets on
3 foot, promotes or carries on in any place whatsoever any
4 public exhibition of the human form with the sex organ
5 exposed, or any representation of the same shall be
6 punished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars
7 nor more than one thousand dollars or by imprisonment
8 for not more than two years, or by both such fine or im-
9 prisonment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not apply to such minors
2 herein described as are licensed by the school committee
3 of the city or town in which they reside to attend any
4 such exhibition for purposes of education.
