## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

### AN ACT

To provide for defraying the Expenses of Delegates to the Annual Convention of the National Guard Association of the United States.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The governor is hereby authorized to  
2 appoint from among the Massachusetts National Guard  
3 Association delegates, at his discretion, to represent the  
4 militia of the commonwealth at the annual conventions  
5 of the National Guard Association of the United States.  
6 The necessary expenses of the delegates so appointed  
7 shall be paid out of the appropriation for military  
8 accounts.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
