RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the Westborough State Hospital.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth a sum not exceeding ten
3 thousand dollars, to be expended at the Westborough
4 state hospital under the direction of the trustees thereof
5 for the following purposes: For constructing and fur-
6 nishing a sanatorium for forty tuberculous women pa-
7 tients, a sum not exceeding six thousand dollars; for
8 constructing a sewage reservoir and connecting it with
9 the present sewage system and providing a suitable cov-
10 ering therefor, and for necessary apparatus for pumping
11 sewage, a sum not exceeding four thousand dollars.
