Bill accompanying the petition of William H. O'Brien for legislation to authorize the city of Boston to provide a pension or other form of relief for the widow and children of John Gorham. Cities. June 1.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to provide for the Widow and Children of John Gorham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized
2 to pay the sum of fifteen dollars monthly to widow
3 of John Gorham, who was drowned while in the service
4 of the street department of the city, on May twenty-fifth,
5 nineteen hundred and ten, so long as the said widow
6 remains unmarried; and there shall be paid to her for
7 the support of her eight children the sum of four dollars
8 a month for each child, until the child attains the age of
9 sixteen years.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
