RESOLVE

In Addition to a Resolve to provide for Certain Improvements at the Wrentham State School.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 seventy-six thousand five hundred dollars, to be expended
4 at the Wrentham State School, under the direction of the
5 trustees, for the following purposes:— For constructing
6 and furnishing a building for one hundred and thirty
7 custodial patients, a sum not exceeding sixty-five thou-
8 sand dollars; and for constructing and furnishing a
9 house for employees, a sum not exceeding eleven thou-
10 sand five hundred dollars.
