RESOLVE

To authorize the Sale of Certain Buildings on the State
Camp Ground.

1 *Resolved*, That the adjutant general is hereby author-
2 ized to sell and cause to be removed any buildings on
3 the state camp ground at South Framingham which, in
4 his opinion, are unsafe or unsuitable for any purposes
5 of the militia, and the proceeds of any such sale shall
6 be paid into the treasury of the commonwealth.
