### AN ACT

In relation to the Powers of Administrators with the  
Will Annexed.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—*

1    SECT. 1. Upon the petition of an administrator  
2 with the will annexed, or of any person interested,  
3 the probate court may, after notice thereof published  
4 three weeks successively in such newspaper as the  
5 court shall designate, and such further notice as the  
6 court shall order, and a hearing of the case, grant to  
7 such administrator any or all powers given by the  
8 will to the executor thereof.

1    SECT. 2. Upon the granting of such petition the  
2 court may require the administrator to file such  
3 further bond as it may deem proper.
