AN ACT

To establish the Boundary Line between the Towns of
Harwich and Orleans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 The boundary line between the towns of Harwich
2 and Orleans is hereby established as follows: Begin-
3 ning at a stone monument standing on the bank at
4 the south-east corner of the town of Brewster, thence
5 south thirty-two degrees and twenty minutes east to
6 a point in the middle of Pleasant Bay where said
7 line intersects a line extending west one degree north
8 from a rock standing in the water on the most
9 northerly point of Strong Island. Said lines are
10 based on lines and angles on and with the true
11 meridian.
