AN ACT

To establish a law term of the Supreme Judicial Court at Plymouth, within and for the County of Plymouth, and to change the time of holding the October term of the Superior Court in said County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. A law term of the supreme judicial
2 court, for entering and hearing questions of law, civil
3 and criminal, arising in the county of Plymouth, shall
4 be held at Plymouth annually, on the third Tuesday
5 of October.

1 SECT. 2. Said term shall be taken to be a term for
2 the return of process, entry of appeals, trials, and for
3 all purposes for which a court may be held by a single

4 justice in said county; but no jury shall be summoned
5 for said term, unless an order therefor shall be issued
6 by the justices of said court or one of them, to the
7 clerk of said county.

1 SECT. 3. The term of the superior court for the
2 county of Plymouth now required by law to be held
3 at Plymouth on the third Monday of October
4 annually, shall be held on the fourth Monday of
5 October.
