## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-Six.

### AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Arlington to issue additional Water Scrip, and to limit the amount thereof.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1    SECT. 1. The town of Arlington, for the pur-  
2    poses mentioned in the eighth section of chapter  
3    two hundred and forty-two of the acts of the year  
4    eighteen hundred and seventy-three, may issue  
5    notes, scrip or certificates of debt, to be denomi-  
6    nated on the face thereof "Arlington Water Scrip,"  
7    to an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand  
8    dollars, in addition to the amount authorized by  
9    the first section of chapter one hundred and nine-  
10   ty-two of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
11   seventy-four, to be issued upon like terms and con-  
12   ditions, and with like powers, in all respects, as are  
13   provided in said acts for the issue of "Arlington  
14   Water Scrip," by said town: *provided*, that the  
15   whole amount of such water scrip, bonds, notes or

16 certificates issued by said town, under the author-  
17 ity given by this act, and by all other acts, shall  
18 not in any event exceed the amount of three hun-  
19 dred thousand dollars.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
