AN ACT

Concerning the election of Town Officers in Williamstown.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The election of moderator and town
2 officers in the annual town meeting in Williams-
3 town, held on the twentieth day of March last past,
4 so far as said election may appear illegal for the
5 reason that the check-list was not used in said
6 election, is ratified and confirmed, and the same
7 shall be taken and deemed good and valid in law
8 to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
