AN ACT

In relation to the Old Colony Railroad Corporation.

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECT. 1. The Old Colony Railroad Corporation
2 may omit to complete, and may discontinue any por-
3 tion of their railroad, in the city of Boston, and, by
4 such omission or discontinuance, shall not lose or im-
5 pair their rights and privileges, conferred by their
6 original charter; *provided*, that this act shall not be
7 construed to continue any right to construct any
8 portion of such railroad, in said Boston, after the
9 time specified in their original charter; nor shall
10 this act be construed to admit the right of said

11 corporation to construct any such portion of said
12 railroad.

1 SECT. 2. The said corporation are hereby author-
2 ized, in pursuance of their contract, to lease the
3 South Shore Railroad, a copy of which is annexed to
4 their Annual Report of January, 1848.
