AN ACT

In addition to An Act to incorporate the Quannapowit
Railroad Company.

*BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :*

1 SECT. 1. The Quannapowit Railroad Company
2 shall hereafter be called and known by the name of
3 the New England Ice Company.

1 SECT. 2. Said company, in addition to their pres-
2 ent powers, are hereby authorized to cut, store and
3 transport ice, from Quannapowit Lake, in South
4 Reading.

1 SECT. 3. Said company are hereby further author-
2 ized to increase their capital stock by forty thousand
3 dollars, and the number of shares of which their
4 capital stock consists, by four hundred shares, and to
5 invest such increase of their capital stock, in such

6 real and personal estate, as may be necessary and
7 convenient for carrying on the business of said cor-
8 poration.

1 SECT. 4. Nothing in this act shall be construed to
2 release said ice company from any and all obligations
3 imposed upon the said Quannapowit Railroad Com-
4 pany by its charter.
